- 1 Skeet, not sure if Jim Vest or Dale Bales will be around to run Skeet, it was agreed to give Mark Bainbridge keys to Clubhouse and Ammo cabinet and a crash course on operating Skeet throwers.
- 2 Micro Wave, 1 or 2 at Archery Clubhouse not being used, move one to Trap Clubhouse since that one quit working.
- 3 HS Trap prices, clays are going to be higher on next order, motion made that when HS teams are shooting as team for practice or score charge \$3. If come for practice on Thursday and not part of a team practice the standard Youth rate of \$2 would apply.
- 4 CD due 4/7/19, 9 months could get 1.75%, 17 months 2%, roll it into the 9 months.
- 5 Fish, order 5 Grass Carp at \$12 each and 50 largemouth bass at \$2.85 each. Approved
