1 Club insurance coverage: Jud Scott (Diamond Brothers Ins. Princeton, IL) gave an overview of policy, buildings would be rebuilt up to amount of coverage. Trap building \$238,000, Archery \$107,000, both \$15000 in contents, Storage building \$1925. Mowers covered at current value up to maximum of \$12000. Throwers would only get \$2500, rebuilt they cost \$7500, Jud to check on increasing coverage for them as well as coverage for electronic gates.
