### New Business

- 1 Shooting range still having trouble with leaving paper, shells, target stands, etc. Paula Adams and Dave Lockhart will check into some cameras.
- 2 Sauk Valley Archers were asking about using 3D course and splitting profits. They were to contact Kevin Cook to begin discussions.
- 3 Paula Adams hired Whoop Your Axe trailer for 2 hours for Family Fun Day, normally \$400 but for Club it's \$200. Steve Grace made motion for Club to pay for it, Dave Lockhart 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion Adopted.
- 4 Paula asked if she could have some money from Club to defray cost of Food, Prizes, etc. for Family Fun Day. Dave Lockhart made motion to allow up to \$500 along with Fishing Derby money, Steve Grace 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion Adopted.
