HUNTING REGULATIONS for COLETA SPORTSMEN'S CLUB

Rules are in addition to all IDNR rules and regulations!

Hunting Regulations

(Squirrel, Rabbit and Cock Pheasant are the only small game allowed to be hunted on Club Property)

- 1) One Cock Pheasant per member per day.
- 2) All hunters must sign in and out at box located in NE Corner of Archery Clubhouse parking lot.

Deer Hunting Regulations

- 1) Two drawings will be held at the August Club Meeting.
- 2) Only members in Good Standing are allowed to enter the drawings.
- 3) Members may enter the Deer Hunt drawings by giving their name during the 3D Shoots, during Trap Shoots, during Skeet Shoots or by contacting any Club Officer. Those receiving names for the drawing will be obligated to forward those names to the Club President prior to the August meeting.
- 4) *One person will be drawn to hunt deer on the East side of the creak.
- 5) *One person will be drawn to hunt deer on the West side of the creak.
 *(only 1 deer per hunter is allowed regardless if harvested with bow or gun or number of permits held)

Fur bearing animals may be hunted by Club members, NO DOGS ALLOWED!

NO TURKEY HUNTING, MIGRATORY BIRD HUNTING OR WATERFOWL HUNTING ON CLUB PROPERTY!

REMINDER-MEMBERS ONLY WHEN USING CLUB PROPERTY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SPECIAL EVENTS.
