Treasurer's Report April

Unfinished Business:

- 1 Pond report: **Water down a little, some algae but not bad, looks like lots of bait fish around edges. Could use some rock in a few places when dries out. Possibly spread some more grass seed in areas on East side.**
- 2 Concrete in front of Trap Club. **No Change**
- 3 Archery Club-Landscape for run off away from building, Bathrooms, Fridge, Microwave?, Baseboard, Floor. **No Change**
- 4 Skeet walkway railings need repair. **Kent Bushman and Steve Grace did some repairs. Won't be too many years entire walkway will need replaced.**
- 5 Docks for pond. **Paula talked to guy again, didn't get enough floats, dock is built, hopefully in soon.**
- 6 Cribs pushing in on trap house 1 & 2 that were replaced. **Trap 1 is OK, Trap 2 Kent Bushman and Steve Grace were able to push sides back out and anchor into concrete.**
- 7 Storm doors at Trap Club House need replaced. **Kent Bushman and Dave Lockhart replaced W door, removed E door and decided not to put storm on as it doesn't get used. Kent has someone lined up to paint both wooden doors.**
- 8 Fence needs replaced at gun range. **No change**
- 9 Sign needs new strips to hold letters. **Paula has been overlapping letters and seems to help. Possibly moving existing strips would help.**

New Business

- 1 Wi-Fi at Archery Club discussed. Cost approximately \$50 to \$60 per month with a onetime cost of a couple hundred dollars for repeaters. Could be used to remotely update gates, renters could stream stuff, campers could have Wi-Fi. Discussion on Cost vs Benefits. No action taken.
- 2 Women's toilets at Archery Club House filling very slow, could be several causes. Gary Linton will look at.
- 3 Paula had a call about doing concealed carry classes. All agreed Archery Club House is better suited for Classroom. It was mentioned Dakota gave \$10 per student. Nobody had a problem as long as Ed Branch wouldn't be upset. Found out the guy doesn't do Hunter Safety. Kent talked to Ed and he has no problem with someone doing concealed carry and/or Hunter Safety. He does plan on doing another one in the spring mainly for the HS Trap Teams.
- 4 815 Bowhunters don't want to give a date as they are busy with baseball and other things. They would like to give out prizes and promote the 9/11-13 Hunter Camp that will be set up like indoor 3D but outdoors. Nobody had a problem with that.
- 5 It was brought up that Jess Peeve takes her dog everywhere and it's not well mannered or trained. She passes it off as a Service Dog but it is not a certified Service Dog.
- 6 Outlet needed on South Side of Archery Club House, could put a plug in between lightbulb and socket in S Entry, or put a outdoor receptacle on pole with hot wire going up to street light.
- 7 Run for Brain Health went very well. Next year workers will park at Trap Club and get transported to Archery Club House. Possibly some attendees if it gets any bigger.

- 8 Kent brought up some issues with Trap machines 1 and 2. He talked to Rod Shyda in PA and will work on them following Rod's advice. Kent hopes got both fixed on 5/19.
- 9 Chris brought up one of the lights in Archery Club House wasn't working. Kent fixed on 5/19.
